Amber Jones introduced our speaker Brian MacConnell, Executive Director, Serenity Recovery Network.

Serenity Recovery Network operates three homes for recovering alcoholics and drug abusers. They enter the homes after rehab. The 3 homes can hold about 27 residents. A resident typically stays in one of the homes about 1 year in the hope that the change in environment will aid in their recovery. Rather than return to a place where they developed the problem. Each resident is required to find a job. They are required to attend counseling sessions each week.
