Presiding today was Mike Kahsar who was standing in for our President Kristina who was recently arrested.

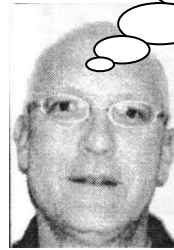

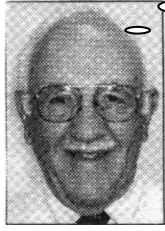
