until he was hit with terminal bone cancer two months ago. He sat closest to the speaker each meeting along with Al Rhein, Tony Michael and Russ Witte, Jim died June 17 in Llanfair Retirement Village, College Hill at the age of 91.

Jim chaired the Public & Business Affairs Committee and he worked in the General Exhibits area of the Harvest Home Fair. He will be greatly missed.

Jim was a proud graduate of Western Hills High School in 1940 just before WW II started. At West High he earned varsity Track & Field letters for throwing the discus and he was a member of Maroon W. He was also an Eagle Scout in the Boy Scouts of America. Jim joined the Marines for WW II, stayed in the Reserve for 6 ½ years and then in the National Guard

for 16 years, retiring as a Major. He enjoyed sharing his Marine Magazine with his Marine buddies.

He received his BA at UC in 1947, and his MA in 1952 and spent 32 years as an educator in the Cincinnati Public School system as a teacher, Assistant Principal and finally a Principal.

He was married to Ester for 54 years and they had three children and three grandchildren.
